American Speech-Language-Hearing Association Award for Continuing Education

The Continuing Education Board (CEB) of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) takes great pleasure in informing you that Ms. Melanie C. Dominko-Richards was granted a str Award for Continuing Education (ACE) on May. 2020. Speech-Language Barle Action and Audiologists and Audiologists may meet the requirements of the ACE by earning seven ASHA Continuing Education Units (CEUS) which is equivalent to 70 contact hours in a thirty-six month period. Credit toward the ACE must be earned within a three-year period; however, some individuals complete the requirements in less time and are awarded successive ACEs in less than three years.
